### Have SAFE and HAPPY Holidays!

The National Fire Protection Association reminds us to check smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors every year. In a 2014 report, the NFPA said three of every five home-fire deaths resulted from fires in homes with no smoke alarms or with none that worked.

*Replace all detectors, - including hardwired detectors, that are older than 10 years. Even when the batteries are good and the test signal responds, dust can desensitize the sensors. Most alarms are coded with the date of manufacture on the back.*

#### Fire extinguishers!

Make sure you purchase the correct size for your area and rating A, B, C, or A:B:C. "A:B:C" is normally found in home stores and can fight all three types of fires: wood combustibles, flammable liquids, and electrical.


*If you use gas to heat your home and water, make sure the appliance's exhaust vent isn't blocked with snow and ice. Make an appointment with a specialist for annual maintenance on gas appliances. Talk to your utility provider for more information.*

*Cooking fires are the number one cause of home fires and the leading cause of fires in the kitchen is unattended cooking. Keep a lid nearby when you're cooking to smother small grease fires. Smother the fire by sliding the lid over the pan and turn off the stovetop. Leave the pan covered until it is completely cooled. Water is useless for a grease fire. For an oven fire turn off the heat and keep the door closed.*

Don't risk it when you smell gas or have a large fire! Get out and stay out. Call 9-1-1 after you leave.

### AND KEEP YOUR PETS SAFE, TOO! Tips from the ASPCA Plan a Pet-Safe Holiday Gathering

*House Rules:* If your animal-loving guests would like to give your pets a little extra attention and exercise while you're busy tending to the party, ask them to feel free to start a nice play or petting session.




*Put the Meds Away:* Make sure all of your medications are locked behind secure doors, and be sure to tell your guests to keep their meds zipped up and packed away, too.

*A Room of Their Own:* Give your pet his own quiet space to retreat to—complete with fresh water and a place to snuggle. Shy pups and cats might want to hide out under a piece of furniture, in their carrying case or in a separate room away from the hubbub.

*New Year's Noise:* As you count down to the new year, please keep in mind that strings of thrown confetti can get lodged in a cat's intestines, if ingested, perhaps necessitating surgery. Noisy poppers can terrify pets and cause possible damage to sensitive ears. And remember that many pets are also scared of fireworks, so be sure to secure them in a safe, escape-proof area as midnight approaches.
